Miss Jacqueline Jones thrilled audiences worldwide with her vocal prowess, crowd engaging smile, and vivacious jazz renditions.

Over the years, Jackie has received many awards and recognition for her work in the local jazz community. She was a founding member of Monday Night Jazz, which started in 2008. Jackie graciously gave her time in support of the Juvenile Diabetes Association, the Steinway Society and the Disney World Youth Jazz Program, just to name a few, while performing at a variety of venues in Florida and worldwide.

Jackie has left a legacy as a remarkable singer who performed and lived a life dedicated to exemplifying excellence, fortitude, tenacity, and commitment. Before she passed, she was notified that she would be honored and recognized for her work and contribution to the jazz community as an inductee into the Central Florida Jazz Society Hall of Fame!

2024 Featured Artist: Beth Haizlip

Beth calls herself a "colorful expressionist artist". "I use bold colorful strokes that make the painting more interesting and not like you are viewing a photograph.

Encouraged by her parents to draw, paint and appreciate art at a very young age, Beth knew she was destined to become an artist. She was born in Charleston, South Carolina and graduated from Florida Southern College in 1980 with a Bachelor of Arts Degree. Beth married her high school sweetheart, a Navy pilot, and had an adventurous life living in California, Hawaii, Texas and Florida. In 1990 they moved to Orange Park, Florida where she maintains her studio in her home. She sells her work at Atlantic Beaches Arts Market, Florida and Dale's Gallery in St. Kitts.



Beth loves painting musical themes. She has done several posters including Jacksonville Jazz poster in 2007 using Van Gogh swirls and impressionist style. Florals and tropical scenes were prevalent in Beth's first art work for the 2016 NSB Jazz Festival that featured one of the cottages on the North Causeway. The original art was won, at auction, by the late Jane Atkinson, a Jazz Fest fan. After Jane's passing, the family donated the piece to Jazz Fest founder, Marc Monteson, and it hangs in his living room.

This year, Beth masterfully captured a scene from the Inaugural 2001 Jazz Fest. The work entitled "Jazz at the Oceanfront Boardwalk" showcases the site of the main event show during that first year.
